An incredibly engaging experience, the Fair invites visitors to explore the meticulously curated galleries, which offer a wide range of prints and works on paper that include new and noteworthy editions.

The Fair is sponsored by the IFPDA and exhibitors are selected for their outstanding ability to offer collectors a diverse survey of 20th and 21st century masterworks including just-published editions by leading contemporary artists.
